The fund can invest locally and offshore and can vary this ratio without any prescribed jurisdictional limits. The mandate is capped at a maximum allocation of 10% to commodities. The fund is notcompliant with regulation 28 of the pension funds act.


#### Objective

The Fund aims to provide moderate to high capital growth and to outperform its benchmark on a risk adjusted return basis over any rolling 24m period. This is achieved by diversifying between unrelated asset classes and the active management of known risks as steered by our investment

#### Strategy

The strategy focusses on active asset allocation as the main contributor of returns. Long standing cause and effect relationships between asset classes and financial indicators is monitored to determine the relative value of asset classes to cash and each other. Tactical decisions are balanced and weighted across multiple valuation disciplines.



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
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#### Historical drawdown analysis
