What is the purpose of this update?^{See note 1}

This document tells you how the FSSA Global Emerging Markets Focus Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. FundRock NZ Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

Objective: To achieve long-term capital growth that exceeds the MSCI Emerging Markets Index (NZD), before fees and taxes, over rolling five-year periods.

Strategy: The Fund invests primarily in large and mid-capitalisation securities in emerging economies, including those of companies listed on developed market exchanges whose majority activities take place in emerging market countries. Emerging market countries are defined as countries which are not classified as developed markets by both MSCI and FTSE. For the avoidance of doubt, a country shall be treated as an emerging market country if it is not classified as a developed market by either the MSCI or the FTSE. The Fund does not hedge currency risk. The Fund may use derivatives for the purpose of reducing risk and/or cost.

What are the risks of investing?^{See note 3}

The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

Example of how this applies to an investor

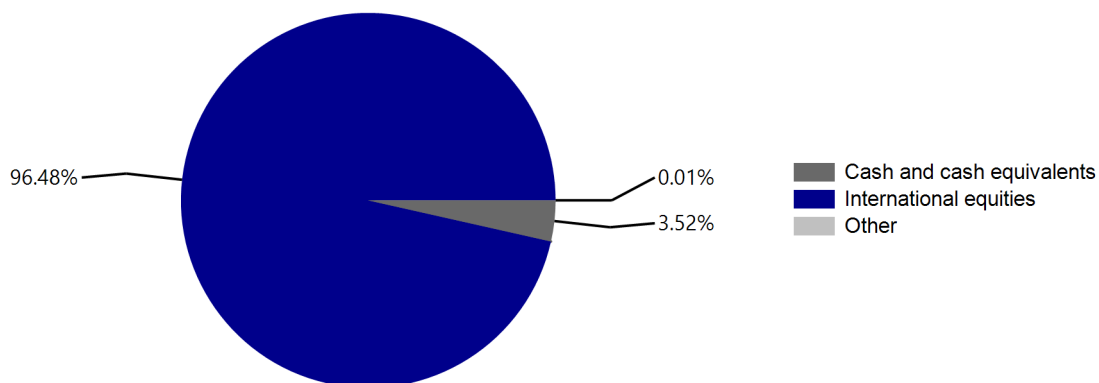
Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Anthony had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Anthony received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$2,271 (that is 22.71% of his initial \$10,000). This gives Anthony a return after tax of \$2,078 for the year.

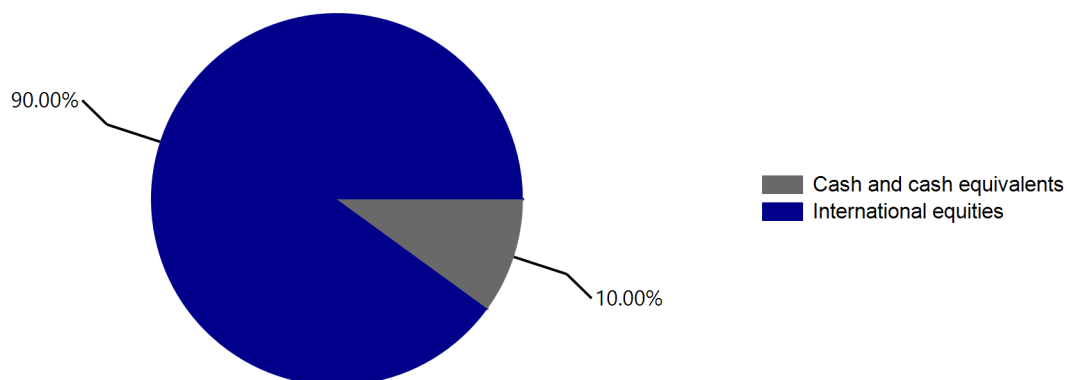
This shows the types of assets that the fund invests in.

Notes

1. On 2 June 2026, the Stewart Investors Worldwide Leaders Fund was renamed the FSSA Global Emerging Markets Focus Fund and the Stewart Investors (NZ) Managed Investment Scheme was renamed the FSSA (NZ) Managed Investment Scheme. This followed the transition of investment management responsibilities and branding from Stewart Investors to FSSA Investment Managers within the First Sentier Group.
2. On 2 June 2026, the market index for the fund changed from MSCI All Country World Index (NZD) to the MSCI Emerging Markets Index (NZD).
3. A combination of actual fund returns, and market index returns have been used to determine the risk indicator as the fund has not been operating for the required five years. Market index returns have been used until 30 September 2022 and fund returns thereafter. The risk indicator may therefore provide a less reliable indicator of the fund's future volatility.
4. The bar chart shows fund returns after deducting fees and tax. Tax is deducted at the highest Prescribed Investor Rate of 28%. However, the market index returns are shown before deducting fees and tax.
