What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Trust Management - ESG International Bond Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the Fund with other funds. Description of this fund

The Fund provides a diversified exposure to international fixed interest securities that meet certain ethical investment criteria.

The investment objective of the Fund is to generate a total return similar to the return of the Bloomberg Global Aggregate Index (100% hedged to NZ dollars), subject to meeting certain ethical investment criteria, before taking into account fees and expenses

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

Example of how this applies to an investor


Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

The Smith Charitable Trust had \$100,000 in the Fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, the Smith Charitable Trust received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$9,460 (that is 9.46% of the initial \$100,000). This gives the Smith Charitable Trust a total return after tax of \$6,750 for the year.

Notes

1. As the Fund has been operating for less than five years, we have used a mix of actual and market index returns for the five-year period to 30 September 2024 to calculate the risk indicator. The risk indicator is based on the market index returns for the 6 months to 31 March 2020 when the Fund was not in existence, and then the actual returns for the 4 years 6 months to 30 September 2024. Therefore, the risk indicator may provide a less reliable indicator of the potential future volatility of the Fund.

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
