What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Russell Investments NZ Shares Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Implemented Investment Solutions Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund


Objective: The underlying investment exposure is typically comprised of a broad range of shares and other equity securities listed on the NZX. This may include derivative instruments which may be used to obtain or reduce exposure to securities and to hedge any Australian dollar exposure. Investment in Australian shares will generally be in those companies which have a listing on the NZX. Where the fund holds Australian equities, the resulting Australian dollar exposure may be hedged to the New Zealand dollar.

Strategy: To provide a total return, before costs and tax, higher than the S&P/NZX 50 Index (gross and including imputation credits) over the long term (3 years plus).



What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Russell Investments NZ Shares Fund.



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.



How has the fund performed?

Annual Return Graph¹



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each year ending 31 March since the fund started. The last bar shows the average annual return since the fund started, up to 30 June 2022.

What fees are investors charged?

Investors in the Russell Investments NZ Shares Fund are charged fund charges. In the year to 31 March 2022 these were:

Fund fees were reduced in December 2021. Hence going forward, we expect total fund charges to be less than in the table above. Estimated total fund charges in the current PDS are 0.79% (including GST).

Example of how this applies to an investor


Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Anthony had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Anthony incurred a loss after fund charges were deducted of 1,367 (that is -13.67% of his initial \$10,000). This gives Anthony a total loss after tax of 1,420 for the year.


What does the fund invest in?
