The Fund is managed by FundRock Partners Limited.

Objective and investment policy

Objective:

The Fund aims to achieve long-term capital growth by the active management of a global multi-asset portfolio.

The Fund is suitable for investors seeking the potential for increased growth but with the potential for slightly greater price volatility.

Policy

- The Fund aims to achieve its objective by investing primarily in passive and actively managed collective investment schemes (OEICs, unit trusts and exchange-traded funds) and closed ended investment companies gaining exposure to global fixed income securities, global equity securities, property securities, infrastructure securities and alternative asset classes.
- The Fund will also have the ability to invest in equities, bonds, money market instruments, cash and near cash deposits.
- The Fund will not invest more than 25% in any single collective investment scheme.
- The Fund may invest up to 95% of the scheme property in more adventurous assets providing potential for more aggressive growth, such as equities, indirect exposure to listed real estate, listed infrastructure and commodities.
- Use may also be made of derivatives for efficient portfolio management purposes.
- The asset allocation of the Fund will be constructed and managed in such a way as to ensure there is diversity within the Fund both by geography and

investment sector, but with a bias to sterling assets that reflects the likely residency of most of the Fund's investors.

Benchmark:

- The Fund will use the IA Flexible Investment sector average as a comparator benchmark for performance monitoring purposes.
- As the benchmark reflects the peer group, which takes a similar level of risk, it is an appropriate benchmark for investors to use to measure the return on the Fund

Other information:

- You can buy and sell shares on most business days where the London Stock Exchange is open for a full range of services.
- The Fund's base currency is Pounds Sterling. We carry out investors' requests, to buy, sell or switch, at midday on each business day (which excludes UK public holidays). If we receive a request after midday, we deal with it on the next business day.
- The high equity weighting in this portfolio means it is likely to experience more price volatility than a more defensively positioned portfolio and should be invested in for the medium to long-term.
- There can be no guarantee that the objective of the Fund will be achieved.
- On encashment, particularly in the short-term, you may receive less than the original amount invested.
- As you hold income shares, income from investments in the Fund will be paid out to you twice a year.


